Dear Parents,

We have just been told of an exciting new opportunity for the West Bedlington Early Years Partnership. Northumberland County Council have been successful in a bid to the Department for Education for funding to replace the Youth Hut, currently used by West End Pre-School and Trinity Youth Association Out of School Club, with a new building on the West End First School site. Understandably, this will cause some disruption for all involved but rest assured that the safety and security of the children will, of course, be our first priority.

Continuity of provision is vital for the children and yourselves and we will be seeking to ensure that these changes do not have an adverse effect on your child's education and care. We are only in the earliest stages of planning and as yet there is no timescale for the project, however, we are currently exploring other venues for the affected groups and will inform you as soon as possible what the arrangements for your child will be.

We hope that you will be just as excited as we are about this news and that any short term issues we encounter will all prove to be worth it when the new building is in place.
